



Accessible Van Driver – Weekends

(Part Time – up to 20 hrs per weekend)

Family Service Kent invites applications for a part-time Driver position for weekend shifts that are scheduled Friday evening through Sunday. Drivers will provide accompanied accessible transportation to individuals across Chatham-Kent and will also assist transportation service users door-to-door, to and from the vehicle, and assist with any mobility aids they may use. Drivers will also collect payment from transportation service users as required. Additionally, drivers will be responsible for completing daily vehicle safety and maintenance checks. Some weekday shifts may be available as needed.

Minimum requirements:

- Availability to work weekend shifts (Friday evening through Sunday)
- 25 years of age and older (for insurance purposes)
- 2+ years' work-related skill, knowledge, and/or experience in driving and in transporting people.
- A valid G Driver's License, clean MTO Driver's Abstract, and clear Vulnerable Persons Check
- Must be computer literate, have experience in Windows and Microsoft Office, and can learn new software
- Must have experience operating GPS navigation systems, smartphones, and Android-based software
- Ability to lift 50 lbs and experience working with mobility aids
- Alignment with Family Service Kent's mission, vision, and values to provide services to individuals, families, and communities
